- ✓ Specialist cleaning throughout whole venue, with a particular focus on touch-points such as door handles, light switches, reception, speaker areas, stages etc. using appropriate cleaning products and methods

- ✓ On entry to the venue all individuals are expected to use the antibacterial gel provided. There are hand sanitisation stations in prominent locations around the venue.

- ✓ All Etc. Venues staff are fully trained on all hygiene measures and supplied with the latest Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).

- ✓ No requirement for social distancing (however all staff / individuals onsite will be reminded of the importance of respecting individual preferences, and comfortability in respect of social distancing)

- ✓ Food prep - Certification of highest standards of cleaning, front and back of house.

- ✓ No contact - Individual bento boxes, served at Buffet style stations

- ✓ Masks encouraged but not mandatory, However Netlaw Media staff will continue to wear face coverings as well as etc. venues staff. (When seated masks can be removed)

- ✓ Protective screens on reception desks to reduce personal contact

- ✓ No capacity limits. However, additional space has been set for the comfort of attendees.

- ✓ Venue encouraged to take steps to ensure adequate ventilation, with adapted plan for arrival, registration, F&B service and communal lounges.

- ✓ Health Screening Questionnaire will be issued:
 - Proof of negative rapid lateral flow test (required before entry can be permitted)
 - or**
 - Negative result from PCR test within 48 hours
 - and or**
 - Confirmation of double dose of vaccine.

- ✓ Covid-status certification via the NHS app (spot check will be undertaken)

- ✓ NHS QR code will be on display for anyone wishing to check in using the app, However, this is not a legal obligation

- ✓ Attendees must also be fully aware, and conscientious of their own personal risk and communicate any concerns with the event organiser
